ng the Devil to revenge her on one John Start who. ived in the same House, he quickly after Sickhed Dyed, so that she then thought he could do as Cod, and thereupon defired him to joyn in that Vicked and Develish Art, Mathew Hopkins, alfo aposed that the said Prisoner Confessed to him since Prison, that the Devil came to her one Night as the was going to Bed, and told her he would Mary her, and that he then kissed her, but was as cold as Clay, id that he took her by the Hand and leading her abut he Chamber a turn or two, he faid they were larried, and promised to be her Loving Hu band, and to avenge her of her Enimies; and that the lent he Devil to Kill the said John Hart, which was done accordingly. Thomas Hart Father of the Deceated Depoled that he verily believed that his Son dyed by Witchcraft, and that during his Torture he heard him cry out against Rebecca West; a Docter of Physick alfo spoke to the same Effect, as did several otheres; Hook which being asked by the Court what she could fay for herfelf, she only alledged that her great Povety had a ccasion'd all this, and pleaded guilty, desiring Mercy, but the Jury after having received their Charge, Imediatly brought her in guilty of Murther hand Witch-craft.

Then Margaret Landish, was brought to the Bar, and Arrain'd for Witch crast, and Diabolical Sorcey, Fro.
